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OPTIONAL CHEST DRAPE CONSENT FORM

According to updated Washington State law (WAC 246-830-560), a client may choose to have their upper torso/chest undraped during the massage therapy session with written and informed consent regardless of sexual identification.

I never need to drape the sheet below the top of the pec muscles as I do not currently practice breast massage and I can access the abdomen by using a chest drape. But clients may have a personal preference for not using a chest drape.

I will verbally ask for your consent before undraping the chest beyond the upper pectoralis muscles, even with established written consent. I practice conservative Washington state mandated draping practices to maximize the client's comfort and safety.

You, the client, have the right to discontinue a session or part of a session at any time for any reason. You may request a drape or extra coverage at any time for any reason. You may have a witness in the room while you receive bodywork at any time for any reason. Treatment is about YOUR well-being. Your comfort and safety are my #1 priority.
